Rib Policy

RIB Policy

The RS Tera Class Association have purchased a rib which will be available for class members to use.

The primary use of the boat will be to support the following:

- 1) Any RS Tera Class Association event
- 2) Recognised Club events open to RS Tera Class Association (at fuel cost only)
- 3) Reasonable use by the custodian of the RIB (at fuel cost only).
- 4) Approved RS Tera Class Association members (Fuel + small reasonable daily charge £30)
- 5) Other Associations (Fuel + reasonable daily charge £65)

(4 and 5) to be approved by the Class Association committee prior to event

The rib is signed over to a custodian who will take on the responsibility of making sure the rib gets to our squad weekends and events, at the same time oversee the booking process for the boat, book the boat in for any necessary service and make sure the rib is returned in as good as condition it was lent out.

For resources booked out in your name you will receive, by email, confirmation of the boat, a link to the reporting forms and any other relevant information such as where/when to collect and return.

The allocated resource will be your responsibility for the agreed period and until such time as it has been returned as pre-arranged by the relevant custodian.

On collection please note any missing items, faults and damage.

You must read the 'BEST PRACTICE' document before using RS Tera Class Association boats.

Only eligible persons may use RS Tera Class Association resources (PB2 minimum). You must ensure you are an eligible driver both car and boat and be aware of the procedures and requirements of the custodian.

The relevant on line report must be filled in within 24hrs of return with any faults or missing items reported to the custodian. Non reported faults will be charged.
