- Promote the RS Tera ethics and core values
- Place winning in the context of fun, fair play and good sportsmanship; emphasise development rather than outcome
- Promote good seamanship, water safety and the sport as a whole
- Show respect to class and race officials
- Check conditions on the water; ensure children are sunblocked, equipped and fit for the prevailing conditions
- Encourage innovation and thought on how to make the boat easier to sail; be sure that you stay within the class rules (contact the Club Secretary if you have any doubts)
- Never provide coaching during a race; a relaxed happy child will perform!
- You are responsible for the behaviour of you child off the water; bad behaviour reflectson the class as a whole.
